Delegates

Resolutions

Resolutions you or your organization want to be considered at the HOD are due by 5 PM on Wednesday, March 1. This is a firm deadline and items of business received after that day and time will be forwarded to the Rules & Credentials Committee for consideration and recommendation.

We ask that resolutions be properly formatted, well thought out and constructed, and any research to document the author's resolved clause is included. This is a *substantial* help to reference committee staff. Authors should include policy citations from MSSNY's position statements but remember – resolutions that repeat existing policy will likely wind up on the reaffirmation calendar!
